CERTIFICATE I IN LEADERSHIP DEVELOPMENT

Certificate I in Leadership Development is targeted at youth and others who wish to gain employability skills to assist with personal development, work exploration and career building.

To achieve the Certificate I in Leadership Development participants must successfully complete a total of 8 core units and 3 elective units of competency:

- GENENP101B APPLY AN ENTERPRISING APPROACH IN A TEAM PROJECT
- GENOHS101B FOLLOW OHS POLICIES AND PROCEDURES

LDWA101 DEVELOP SELF

This unit provides the underpinning knowledge and insights required to identify attributes of self

LDWA102 INTRODUCTION TO APPLIED LEADERSHIP

To provide participants with an insight into what leadership is and a leader's impact on others.

LDWA103 EFFECTIVE TEAM MEMBERSHIP

To provide participants with the knowledge and skills required for participation in a group as an effective team member.

LDWA104 PERSONAL ROLE IN SOCIETY

Focuses on the rights and responsibilities of a citizen as well as the levels of government in Australia.

LDWA105B DEVELOP PROBLEM SOLVING SKILLS

This unit provides a participant with the knowledge and skills required to identify problems, explore possible solutions and work with others to evaluate, agree on and implement a solution.

BSBCMM101A APPLY BASIC COMMUNICATION SKILLS

Development of communication skills in the workplace. It covers the activities of gathering, conveying and receiving information, together with completing assigned written information under direct supervision.

GENENP101B APPLY AN ENTERPRISING APPROACH IN A TEAM PROJECT

This unit covers the skills and knowledge needed to work effectively as part of a team to undertake a project which requires initiative and enterprise to be exercised.

GENOHS101B FOLLOW OHS POLICIES AND PROCEDURES

This unit covers the skills and knowledge necessary to follow defined occupational health and safety policies and procedures related to work being undertaken in order to ensure own safety and that of others in the workplace.

ELECTIVE UNITS

The Certificate I in Leadership Development contains 3 elective units. These units will be confirmed prior to the course and may include units from Business, Communication, IT, Sustainability and Workplace Effectiveness.
