## Descriptor



This qualification covers workers who follow the policies and procedures of an organisation and depending on the setting assist with the planned activities and day to day care of children, youth or adults under direct supervision. This course is available only to Non Compulsory Post Secondary Students enrolled in Structured Workplace Learning.

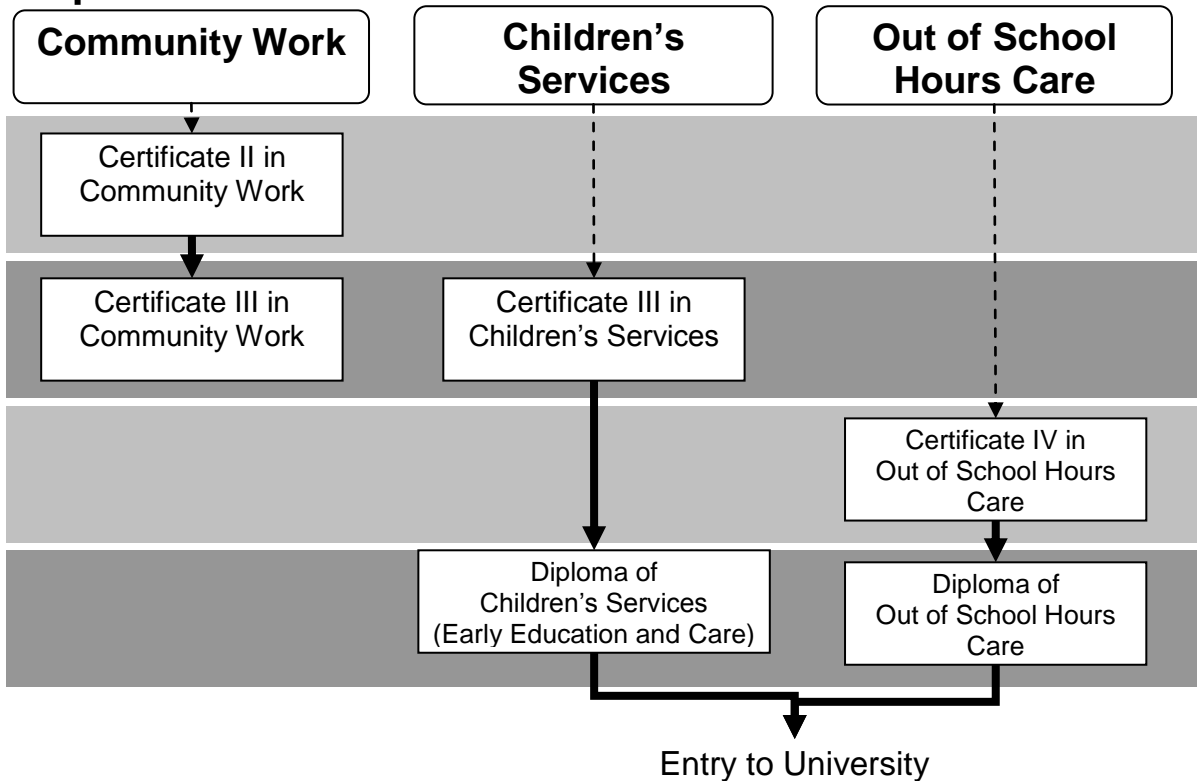

## Information for Children's Services



Delivery will be over 2 years consisting of 15 days of theory each year. Certificate III would be offered in year 12 on successful completion of year 11 units. Work placement will be one day per week once theory is complete

## Descriptor

This qualification covers workers who use organisational policies, procedures and individual children's profiles to plan activities and provide care to children, facilitating their leisure and play and enabling them to achieve their developmental outcomes. Depending on the setting, workers may work under direct supervision or autonomously. In some settings, the worker may also have limited supervisory responsibilities.
