UEE22020 Certificate II in Electrotechnology (Career Start) Electrotechnology Pre-apprenticeship

(VET delivered to secondary students)



OVERVIEW

Pre-apprenticeships in schools are Certificate II programs that have been nominated by Western Australian industry training councils as valid pathways from school to a traditional trade apprenticeship.

This nationally accredited qualification is designed to provide participants with industry specific training to gain skills, knowledge and behaviours to enable transition into an apprenticeship in the Electrotechnology Industry.

CONTENT

This course has 8 core, 5 elective and 4 work placement units of competency - visit cet.asn.au to view the unit details.

REQUIREMENTS

This qualification is delivered under pre-apprenticeship arrangements. Places for pre-apprenticeships in schools are limited. Students should contact the Highschool VET Coordinator and are required to:

- Be commencing year 11
- Have support from their school including endorsement of work readiness;
- Undertake a literacy and numeracy pre-selection test administered by the College. The test is of a Year 11-12 level and is specific to transposition of formula, trigonometric ratio and algebra;

- Meet specific industry licensing requirements; and
- Meet Australian citizenship or visa requirements

To be able to complete on the job work placement, students must be able to obtain an Electrical Training Licence. The application process will commence on the first day of the course. Relevant licence fee is payable by the student on application.

DURATION

This course is delivered over 2 school years.
