52887WA Certificate II in Plumbing (Plumbing Pre-Apprenticeship)

About this course

This course will provide you with the practical skills and knowledge required for a career in the Plumbing and Servicing industry. You will learn skills in basic plumbing, how to weld using oxy-acetylene and how to cut and join sheet metal. As part of this course you will undertake a supervised work placement where you will be able to apply the skills and knowledge you have learned.

Successful completion over the two years will provide you with a Certificate II qualification and a Statement of Academic Record which will be credited toward a pathway in an apprenticeship training program. You will need to be employed and registered as an apprentice before you can commence your apprenticeship training program.
