#### About the course

Passionate about learning how to apply make-up professionally to yourself and others? Looking to work in the retail, make-up and skincare industry? If you answered yes to both of these questions then this could be the perfect course for you!

This course will teach you how to create the right look for day, evening and special occasions as well as popular techniques such as smokey eye, classic eye and camouflage. You will also learn an introduction to retail operations and how to promote a range of beauty products.

The course is designed to meet the needs of students who have not already completed a qualification in Beauty Therapy.
